

Holbrook Permit Fees

ELECTRICAL PERMIT FEES

EFFECTIVE June 1, 2002

LIABILITY INSURANCE COVERAGE AND COMPLETED OPERATIONS COVERAGE IS REQUIRED IN THE FORM OF A CERTIFICATE OF INSURANCE.

NOTICE: ELECTRICAL PERMITS GOOD FOR ONE (1) YEAR ONLY. A \$25.00 FEE TO RENEW IS REQUIRED

PERMITS ISSUED AND NOT STARTED IN SIX (6) MONTHS EXPIRE.

FIVE DAY FILING LAW: ALL PERMITS FILED FIVE (5) DAYS AFTER JOB IS STARTED WILL BE CHARGED DOUBLE FEES.

DOUBLE ORIGINAL FEES: *for electrical work being done without an issued or paid permit.*

REPAIR AND MAINTENANCE PERMIT: *annual fee \$50.00. Employing a licensed Electrician or hiring an outside contractor for repair and maintenance only on the premises. All other work requires a permit.*

REINSPECTIONS: \$35.00 FEE: *inspections for defective work, extra inspections and any other inspections required, payable before inspection.*

RESIDENTIAL FEE: *Initial charge of \$25.00 plus \$3.00 per hundred dollar value of the actual electrical work fee charged to owner or ugent.*

COMMERCIAL FEE – INDUSTRIAL/MERCANTILE: *Initial charge of \$25.00 plus \$3.00 per hundred dollar value of the electrical work on the first \$10,000⁰⁰ then \$2.00 per hundred dollar.*

NOTE: *The above fees are based on TWO INSPECTIONS; namely ROUGH AND FINISH, SERVICE INSPECTION IS A SEPARATE FEE UNLESS WITH ROUGH OR FINISH. All additional inspections required for any reason the fee is \$25.00 per inspection, due before inspection.*
